1. Seasonal Flu

Date are going to be held on 6,7 and 13 October. We are also now doing children's vaccinations for 2, 3 and 4 year olds and pilot scheme of years 7 and 8 in high school. This will hopefully stop the spread of flu. Administered via a nasal spray for children and has been proven to be very effective. Looking at half term for children in years 7-8.

2. Questions were asked regarding the new surgery in crossgates. This was explained that only Manston and Church View surgery were moving into the building and that we were no longer included due to the fact that the areas allocated to us was too small and Dr Rose pulled out of the planning. Also parking is limited as there is big encouragement is given to walking. The surgery feels that we could lose our personal touch being in a large building.

3. Shingles – the vaccines are now to be given to 70, 78 and 79 on a monthly basis and 1 lasts a lifetime. All searches are made on a monthly basis. Patients will be contacted directly.

4. Pneumonia – available from 65 years old unless immune compromised. 1 injection and last a lifetime.

5. Walk in centres were discussed as an alternative to A&E in out of hours.
